Eligibility Criteria

A. General Criteria

- i. Being a student or a graduate of the higher education system;**
- ii. There is no limitation to the number of themes chosen for participation on condition that a separate form is completed for each theme (maximum works to be submitted for each theme is 5);**
- iii. Faxed inputs are not acceptable;**
- iv. The registration form must be accompanied by a copy of the participant's student card and a 3.4 photograph of the applicant;**
- v. University graduates are requested to submit a copy of their latest degree and/or nomination letter from the University of their Graduation, a photograph of the size 3.4, and their registration form.**

B. Special Criteria

- i. Written documents must be submitted in type-written form, in 3 copies, with each page on one side of an A4 (CDs in Microsoft word must be included).**

Caricature

- i. Original copy (ies) of the work is requested. In the case of digital cartoons, a resolution of 300dpi and a Jpg or Tiff format is required as well as an A4 print;**

- ii. Submitted prints should bear the size of A4 in minimum and A3 in maximum Video Clips
 - i. The least playback time is 3 and the most determined as 12 mins;
 - ii. Video clips should be in high quality DVD format;
 - iii. Each DVD must bear a label, depicting the title.

Photographs

- i. Photographs can be submitted in either color, or black and white form; they can be either digital, or analogue;
- ii. Photographs should not be smaller than 20.30 cm, or bigger than 50.70 cm;
- iii. Photographs must be printed in the given sizes and accompanied by a digital file of 20.30 cm, a resolution of 300dpi and a format of either Jpg, or Tiff.
- Photographs and cartoons (caricatures) should not be framed

Special Section of the Festival

The special section is targeted at:

- i. Iranian and non- Iranian students at colleges and universities .
- ii. Iranian and non- Iranian graduates from colleges and universities .

Participation in this section also requires the submission of works along with the applicants completed registration form. All documents, etc must be submitted to the festival secretariat.

- Written documents by international students must be submitted in either Persian, English, French or Arabic.

- **Submissions by visually impaired participants are also acceptable in Braille.**
