The **Full Paper** should be between 5,000 to 7,000 words. Papers received before the deadline will be included into the Indexed Conference Proceedings. The best paper will be published in a publication and posted on the UNESCO website.

2. Deadline: abstracts **MUST BE RECEIVED** no later than 20 September 2012
3. Online abstracts submissions are required.
4. Presenting authors must pay the registration fee and attend the meeting.
5. Participants are responsible for their own travel costs.
6. All accepted abstracts will be published and distributed electronically in the Conference Materials. Hardcopy syllabus booklets will be available for purchase during the conference. Abstracts and digital posters (if submitted) will also be published online at www.ysdwl.cn/conference2012

Content of the Abstract

1. The body of the abstract is limited to 300 words
2. Body of the abstract: purpose of the study, methods used, summary of the results and conclusion reached.
3. Author list is limited to 10.
4. References and credits **MUST NOT** be included in the abstract.
5. Simple tables may be made in the submission form –PLEASE DO NOT PASTE TABLES IN THE ABSTRACT BODY.

6. Formulas should be avoided.
7. Use standard abbreviations in parentheses after the full word the first time it appears.
8. Please indicate the subject category your abstract most closely represents:
 - a) **Fundamental Human Ethics: Unique or Common?**
 - b) **Comparison between Ethics in My Country and Other Countries: Is there Any Common Ground?**
 - c) **How is Ethics Apply in Living as a Community?**
 - d) **The Impacts of Ethics on the Way People Think and Live.**
